Eligibility

Participants must be:

- A member with full playing privileges of their club;
- The Club must be a Golf Canada member in good standing, via membership with either Golf Ontario or Golf Quebec;
- Weekday, senior, junior and intermediate memberships qualify.

Team Rosters & Substitutions

- Captains must fill out their Team Roster Forms and ensure that each Captain in their Division receives a copy of the draw prior to the day of play.
- Order of play will be determined by handicap index provided on the Team Roster Form.
- The highest handicap index plays in the 10th position moving to the lowest playing in the 1st position.

Team Rosters & Substitutions

- Order of play: Alternates first, followed by the 10th place player up to the 1st placed player.
- Substitutions can be made up until the first tee time.
- If the Alternate must move into a playing position, he will play in the position in which his handicap index falls on the roster. As a result, other players may be moved up or down.
- The player in the first Alternate position moves onto the roster first.

Caddies, carts and spectators

Caddies

- Players and caddies should be advised that caddies are there for the player's benefit and should refrain from commenting or making suggestions to other players.
- Players and their caddies may not ride in the same cart.

Carts

- OVGA policy of 2-cart maximum per foursome applies.
- One cart per club will be made available for Team Captains.

Spectators

- May not give advice and should not attempt to communicate with players
- Are not permitted to use motorized transportation at tournaments
- *Spectator Code of Conduct* available for download at ovga.org under the “Tournaments” tab
- Non-playing Captains are permitted to communicate with players

Practice rounds

- The practice round, *if available at all*, may be offered at no charge, at a reduced rate or the players may be required to pay the Club's standard fee.
- These arrangements are entirely at the discretion of the Host Club and should be limited to only the players of a Visiting Team (including the alternate).

Information to share with team

1. Tees in use
2. Pace of play
3. Procedure when matches are completed
4. Order of play
5. Specific local rules (OVGA strongly supports the use of Summer Rules but decision is the Host Club's). Make sure your players are aware what rules are in effect
6. Should a player complete their matches prior to the 18th hole, they should sign the scorecard and exit the golf course
7. Following completion of round, all players should proceed to scoring area immediately

Food and Beverage

- The arrangement for refreshments after the matches is at the discretion of the Host Club
 - Should the Host Club offer refreshments, visiting Captains should confer with the Host Club about such arrangements and determine whether caddies may be included in the celebration and if so at what charge.
 - Method of payment of any fees owing (e.g., carts, food, beverages, etc): the Captains of the Visiting Teams should determine whether the Host Club operates on a cash system or if the Visiting Clubs will be billed one amount.
