



## OTTAWA VALLEY GOLF ASSOCIATION

### Procedures for Adult Intersectionals (revised May 5, 2023)

1. **Registration:** Will consist of registering your club only (not individual team members) via Golf Genius. The team captain or designated person will log into Golf Genius and register on behalf of their club. At that time, there will be a required payment of \$100.00 + hst for each visiting club (Host Clubs do not pay but must register). Registering by the designated deadline will ensure entry and commitment to participate.
2. **Submission of Team Rosters:** Will be expected at the Captain's Meeting. The Captain's Meeting will be held virtually, one week prior to each event. If you are a Host Club, please ensure you have a representative at this meeting.

Team Captains should have a roster with a complete list of members of their team, in playing order from highest to lowest Handicap Index, and including Alternates. The Team Captain shall sign and date the roster indicating that all Handicap Indexes have been checked and all players meet the Eligibility Criteria. The rosters will be shared with all clubs within their respective division as well as the OVGA Director of Intersectionals.

The Handicap Indexes are frozen at the time these rosters are presented at the Captain's Meeting.

*There will also be a Captain's Meeting 1 hour prior to the first tee time where the Host Club will post the rosters on the official OVGA scoring sheet.*

3. **Team Composition:** The Men's Regular Intersectional will consist of ten (10) players and two (2) alternates. The Women's Regular Intersectional teams will consist of seven (7) players and one (1) alternate.

The Senior Men's Intersectional Team is ten (10) players as follows:

Club teams consist of 10 players plus two alternates who are selected by their Clubs in qualifying rounds. Teams must be made up of 7 players aged 55 and up (as of the day of play) plus 3 players aged 65 and up. As the alternates must be able to substitute for any player, it is recommended that the alternate be 65+.

The Senior Women's Intersectional Team is seven (7) players as follows:

All players must be at least 50 years of age (as of the day of play) with at least one player who is 65 or older. As the alternate must be able to substitute for any player, it is recommended that the alternate be 65+.

4. **Caddies:** Will be permitted for all Adult Events.
5. **Pace of Play:** Is expected to be kept by all players. Keep up to the group in front. In consideration of the Host Club and other players in the competition, a player shall play without undue delay. Please remember Match Play rules are in effect and putts may be given and holes may be conceded if appropriate and are encouraged for Pace of Play.
6. **Scoring:** In Match Play is based on holes won, lost or tied. Each Host Club player will keep the Official Score Card to be handed in at the end of the match. Each player **MUST** sign the Official Score Card at the end of the match and prior to leaving the course. If at the end of the competition, there is a dispute and a card is without signature, the Official Score Card will stand as presented.
7. **Ties:** Will be decided at the end of the competition by the following procedure.
  - a) The matches played between the two tied teams are considered, with the team having the greater number of points in these matches being the winner.
  - b) If the teams are still tied after (a), the individual matches between the tied teams, starting with the lowest handicap players (i.e., the last to tee off) are considered on a sudden-win basis until the tie is broken.
8. **Termination of Play:** Due to inclement weather or darkness
  - Every effort will be made to ensure that all matches are completed, due to the impossibility of rescheduling the competition.
  - Any matches that have not completed the stipulated round will be decided by the standing in the match at the last hole completed.
  - Should teams be tied at the termination of play, the placing will be decided by the formula set out under Ties.
